

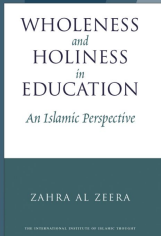
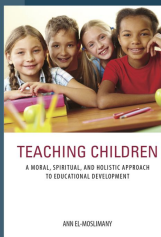
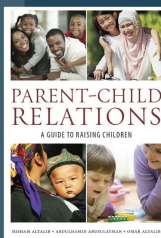

FAQ

How can I be sure the IIIT books meet academic standards?

We send all manuscripts to 2-3 peer-reviewers before we make decisions on publication. Our peer-reviewers are leading professors and researchers at institutions in the US, Canada, and Europe.

Will you publish my thesis or dissertation?

Yes, dissertations and theses in education will be considered. However, they will need to be revised into book form meeting IIIT criteria before being submitted to us.

Will you help me secure permission to use copyrighted material?

Authors are best situated to secure permission to use copyrighted material, as well as to make sure that the manuscript is free of plagiarism or copyright violations.

How long will it take to publish my manuscript?

Editorial requirements differ dependent on the level and stages of work demanded of each manuscript. Whilst no firm timeline can be offered, we try to meet a general duration of 18 months from approved copy to print stage.
